Instructions:

Try to choose one that feels like it's the right level – you understand most of it, but hear some new words, too! You may choose to do an activity after watching the story, but you do not have to. Remember that while these stories are meant to teach you German, they should be enjoyable! What to do after the story?

- * Watch the video again. Pause it to draw pictures and label them in German and English.
- * Watch the video again and read along. You will have to email me to request the text for most of the stories. Unless they are copyright-free, I cannot post them publicly. But I'm happy to email you a copy!
- * Watch the video again and try to act out the story as you listen. Maybe use costumes & props! Have fun!
