## **Was für Wetter haben wir heute?**

Using the weather chart:

Instead of asking: "Wie ist das Wetter heute?" (How is the weather today? Or, What is the weather like today?), I like to ask: "**Was für Wetter haben wir heute?**" (What kind of weather do we have today?).

That way, children are answering with the noun form (die Sonne – sun – die Wolken – clouds – etc.) to start.

This coincides with the weather vocabulary posters I use to introduce the words, as well.

I also like to ask: "**Was sehen wir aus dem Fenster?**" (What do we see out the window?).

In class, I will go through the list and ask about each item: "**Sehen wir die Sonne?**" (Do we see the sun?), etc.

For each thing that we see, you can put a check in the box for that day.

Weather Cards:

You can print out the weather cards in color or black & white. Hang the whole sheet next to your chart, so you can practice the words. Or cut them out and use as flashcards. Make two sets and play memory!
